


## **Plywood Edging Veneer**

The grain and color of veneer edging tape doesn't always match the hardwood plywood used on a project. To solve this problem, you can make your own edging strips by removing a thin layer of veneer from your leftover scraps of plywood, as shown below.



To cut the veneer free, turn the plywood on edge. Set the fence to remove the veneer and about \(^{1}/\_{32}\)" of the core material.



A belt sander quickly removes the excess core material from the veneer. Clamp the strip to a backing board while sanding.
